### What do you get from the course?

**Young Sailor Levels 1 & 2 & 3** range from a 'taster' to sailing the boat yourself. Level 3 is equivalent to 'Adult Level 2'.

**RYA Adult Level 1 - *Start Sailing*** - aimed at novices and including basic boat handling. You will be sailing dinghies with assistance.

**RYA Adult Level 2 - *Basic Sailing Skills*** - builds experience and you can sail a dinghy yourself in light winds.

### What do you need?

**Clothes** - For sailing you will need old-ish warm clothes, a waterproof top and non-slip shoes eg 'plimsolls'. Jeans are not acceptable as when they get wet they stick to you. You may fall in the river so make sure you have a towel and complete change set of warm clothes and shoes.

**Food** - Weekend courses bring Lunch and snacks - Drinks provided

**Medications** - If you need pills, inhalers etc, please ensure that they are clearly labelled with your name and instructions. They will be kept centrally while we are sailing.

### Where is the Trent Lock Scout Water Activity Centre?

From Long Eaton Station take the B6540 towards Sawley. After 1000m turn left at the brown **Trent Lock** Tourist sign into Lock Lane. Park at the end and walk past the right-hand side of the Pub and **straight on** across the pub garden and on to the raised river bank. Turn right along the bank for about 75 yards to the landing stage. Wave across and the ferry will come and pick you up
